### In Remembrance:

Leader: Today, we remember and honor those whose lives were given in service to us:

**People: The 217,000 who served in the Revolutionary War and the 4,435 who died in that service.**

Leader: The 286,730 who served in the War of 1812 and the 2,260 who died in that service.

**People: The 78,718 who served in the Mexican War and the 13,283 who died in that service.**

Leader: The 3,500,000 who served in the Civil War and the 498,332 who died in that service.

**People: The 306,760 who served in the Spanish-American War and the 2,446 who died in that service.**

Leader: The 4,743,826 who served in World War One and the 116,516 who died in that service.

**People: The 16,353,659 who served in World War Two and the 405,399 who died in that service.**

Leader: The 5,764,143 who served in the Korean War and the 54,246 who died in that service.

**People: The 8,744,000 who served in the Vietnam War and the 90,220 who died in that service.**

Leader: The 2,225,000 who served in the Persian Gulf War and the 1,565 who died in that service.

**People: The 6,852 who have died in service to the War on Terror, including Operation Enduring Freedom and Operation Iraqi Freedom.**

Leader: The unknown and unnamed who have served on missions and operations, deployments in war and in times of peace. We remember their sacrifice today.
