**Welcome, Introduction & Invocation**

**Confession & Promise of Forgiveness:**

Leader: This is the message we have heard from Jesus Christ and proclaim to you,

**People: that God is light, and in Him is no darkness at all. [1 John 1:5]**

**People: we lie and do not practice the truth. [1 John 1:6]**

Leader: If we say we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us,

**People: If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness. [1 John 1:8-9]**

Leader: Your sins are forgiven for His name’s sake. [1 John 2:12]

**People: Amen!**
