Leader: This is the message we have heard from Jesus Christ and proclaim to you,

Leader: But, if we walk in the light, as He is in the light, we have fellowship with one another,

People: If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness. [1 John 1:8-9]

Leader: Dear Friends, according to God’s Word and Promise: Your sins are forgiven for His name’s sake. [1 John 2:12]
People: Amen!
