The Book of Joshua, Chapters 21-23:

Chapter 21 – Cities for the Levites:

God had told His people to give special cities to the Levites, the priests who led the tribes in the worship God. So, the Israelites shared their land and gave 48 cities to the Levites. This showed that they were obeying God and working together.

Chapter 22 – A Special Altar:

Some of the tribes had helped win the battles in the Promised Land, and now it was time for them to go home. Before they left, they built a big altar by the river. The other Israelites thought they were disobeying God, but it was actually to remind everyone to keep worshiping the Lord. Once they talked it out, they understood and were happy there was no trouble.

Chapter 23 – Joshua's Goodbye Message:

Joshua was getting old, so he gave a speech to remind the people to love God and obey His commandments. He told them to be strong, keep trusting God, and not to copy the ways of people who didn't follow the Lord. Joshua reminded them that God had kept all His promises—and He would always take care of them if they stayed faithful.
