Leader: This is the message we have heard from Jesus Christ and proclaim to you,

People: we lie and do not practice the truth. *[1 John 1:6]*

Leader: But, if we walk in the light, as He is in the light, we have fellowship with one another,

People: and the blood of Jesus His Son cleanses us from all sin. *[1 John 1:7]*

Leader: If we say we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us,

People: If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness. *[1 John 1:8-9]*

Leader: Dear Friends, according to God's Word and Promise: Your sins are forgiven for His name's sake. *[1 John 2:12]*

People: Amen!
