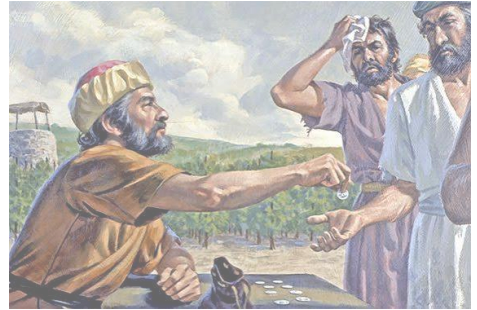


Welcome, Introduction & Invocation

Confession & Promise of Forgiveness:

Leader: This is the message we have heard from Jesus Christ and
proclaim to you,

People: that God is light, and in Him is no darkness at all. [1 John 1:5]

Leader: If we say we have fellowship with Him while we walk in darkness,

People: we lie and do not practice the truth. [1 John 1:6]

Leader: But, if we walk in the light, as He is in the light, we have fellowship with one another,

People: and the blood of Jesus His Son cleanses us from all sin. [1 John 1:7]

Leader: If we say we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us,

People: If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness. [1 John 1:8-9]

Leader: Dear Friends, All who respond to God's call to repentance are embraced in the generous mercy of God. Whether you responded to God's call at the first opportunity, or whether you are responding for the first time now, God's gracious forgiveness is yours, in Jesus Christ. Sisters and Brothers, your sins are forgiven; be at peace.

People: Amen!
